

# Electrical Foundations Evening Classes at Area 31 Career Center for Fall Semester

**Line-worker Track (LW) Electrician Track (EC)**

**LW Program Schedule:** Monday, Tuesday, Thursday; 6:00pm – 9:30pm

**EC Program Schedule:** Tuesday and Thursday, 6:00 pm - 9:30 pm

**Instructional Hours:** LW: 147 hours or EC: 98 hours

**Program Overview:** The WTAE-Career Training Linework and Electrician tracks provide training in the installation, maintenance and repair of electrical systems. Students will learn about electrical safety and become AED/First Aid/CPR certified. Students will work on installing wiring systems, outlets and light switches; inspect circuit breakers and transformers; and repair and replace wiring when needed. Students on the line-worker track will also work on pole climbing, ladder safety, ropes and harnesses, pole safety and rescue procedures. Employment placement opportunities are available to students after the completion of the program.

**Certifications:** Electrical Certification Exam, WIN Essential Soft Skills, and OSHA-10 General Construction, AED/CPR/First Aid Certification.

1. High School Diploma or High School Equivalency (GED/HSE)
2. Indiana Identification (driver's license /state ID).
3. Criminal Background Check
4. Drug Screening (9-Panel)
5. Authorization to work in the US

## SELECTION PROCESS

1. Go to [adulted.info/career](https://adulted.info/career), download and print the **class schedule**, and click "Start Here."
2. Read everything carefully before choosing "Click Here to Get Started!"
3. **Create** a Wayne Township Portal Login with your email and a password.
4. **Complete ALL** required steps in the 2023-24 Career Training Scholarship Portal, which includes watching videos and uploading documents.
5. **Schedule** in-person TABE testing in reading, math, and language.
6. **Complete**— TABE testing 3 hours.
7. **Attend**- a 30-minute virtual interview.

**At the conclusion** of interviewing and testing, the selection committee will review all candidate files.

Competitive selections will be made for awarding of scholarships.

Candidates will be notified of scholarship status by email no later than August 10, 2023.
