## HVAC Technician Evening Classes at Area 31 Career Center for Spring Semester January 24 (Orientation 6-9PM) & January 29 through May 30, 2024

**Instructional Hours:** 98 hours

**Program Overview:** The WTAE-Career Training HVAC Program trains students to work as an entry level HVAC technician. The program teaches how to install and troubleshoot commercial and residential HVAC systems. The course covers fundamentals of electricity, including electrical distribution systems, voltage circuits and low voltage controls. Fundamentals of refrigeration, pressure and temperature relationships and how to install, test and support a refrigeration system. Fundamentals of troubleshooting, troubleshooting electric heat, gas furnaces, oil heating systems and heat pump systems. Students also receive hands-on practice with the latest tools and technologies that professionals are currently employing in the field. **Students have the opportunity to participate in an apprenticeship/work based learning opportunity during the course of this program.** Employment placement opportunities are available to students after the completion of the program. **Certifications:** EPA 608 Certification Exam, WIN Essential Soft Skills, and OSHA-10 General Construction.


