Instructional Hours: 120

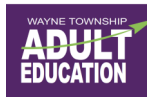
Program Overview: The WTAE-Career Training SDPT Program trains students to work as an entry level sterile device processing technician in a hospital or clinic setting. Students will learn the content knowledge and skills needed to become a vital part of a medical team. Students will learn names of a variety of medical instruments, infection control and how to disinfect clinical instruments, exam rooms, operating rooms. Students will also learn how to maintain sterile environments in order to prevent contamination and infection. Students will complete Clinical Hours within the program. SDPT provisional license requires 400 in-service hours within 6 months of certification. Employment placement opportunities are available to students after the completion of the program.

Mandatory Clinical Rotations during Weeks 9-15

Certifications: HSPA Certification Exam (CRCST), WIN Essential Soft Skills, OSHA-10 Healthcare, and Basic Life Support-CPR Certification

Program Requirements:

1. High School Diploma or High School Equivalency (GED/HSE)
2. Indiana Identification (driver's license / state ID)
3. Social Security card and Employment Authorization card
4. Criminal Background Check
5. Drug Screening (10-Panel)
6. Immunization Record
7. Physician Health Statement

SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS

1. Go to adulthood.info/career, download and print the **class schedule**, and click "Start Here."
2. **Read everything carefully** before choosing "Click Here to Get Started!"
3. **Create** a Wayne Township Portal Login with your email and a password.
4. **Complete ALL** required steps in the 2025-26 Career Training Scholarship Portal, which includes uploading documents.
5. **Schedule** in-person TABE testing in reading, math, and language.
6. **Complete**— TABE testing 3 hours.
7. **Attend**- a 30-minute virtual interview.

At the conclusion of interviewing and testing, the scholarship committee will review all candidate files.

Competitive selections will be made for awarding of scholarships.

Candidates will be notified of scholarship status by email no later than August 13, 2025.
