

ARC Welding Evening Classes at Area 31 Career Center for Spring Semester 2025 January 29 (Orientation 6-9PM) & February 3 through May 29, 2025

Program Overview: The WTAE-Career Training WELD Program trains students to work as an entry level welding technician. The program covers the content of Ivy Tech's WELD 207 course. This program also incorporates basic blueprint reading. Students will learn how to employ safety practices involved in gas metal arc welding. Identify the gases used in gas metal arc welding. Perform routine maintenance on gas metal arc welding equipment. Identify and weld five (5) basic types of joints. Describe constant voltage and wire feed welding processes. Practice hard wire welding techniques using short circuit and spray method welding. In addition to, welding with flux-core tubular wires and aluminum with spray. Students have the opportunity to participate in an apprenticeship/work based learning opportunity during the course of this program. Employment placement opportunities are available to students after the completion of the program. **Mandatory 16-hr Field Experiences will take place during Spring Break.**

Certifications: AWS Gas Metal Arc Welding Certification, WIN Essential Soft Skills, and OSHA-10 General Construction.

Program Requirements:

1. High School Diploma or High School Equivalency (GED/HSE)
2. Indiana Identification (driver's license / state ID)
3. Social Security card and Employment Authorization card
4. Clean Criminal Background Check
5. Drug Screening (10-Panel)

1. Go to adulted.info/career, download and print the **class schedule**, and click "Start Here."

3. **Create** a Wayne Township Portal Login with your email and a password.
4. **Complete ALL** required steps in the 2024-25 Career Training Scholarship Portal, which includes uploading documents.
5. **Schedule** in-person TABE testing in reading, math, and language.
6. **Complete**—TABE testing for 3 hours
7. **Attend** a 30-minute virtual interview.

At the conclusion of interviewing and testing, the selection committee will review all candidate files.

Competitive selections will be made for awarding of scholarships.

Candidates will be notified of scholarship status by email no later than January 23, 2025.
