Program Overview: The WTAE-Career Training DENT Program trains students to work as an entry level dental assistant. Students learn the content knowledge and skills necessary to assist the dentist in the delivery of dental treatment and to function as key members of the dental team. The student will learn an introduction to the field of dentistry, dental terminology, how to assist with diagnosis and prevention, chair-side procedures, assisting with restorative procedures and dental materials, how to take x-rays, laboratory procedures, and dental office management. **Students are required to complete 24 hours of Radiation and Health Safety (RHS) shadowing before the completion of the program during Weeks 12-15.** Employment placement opportunities are available to students.
