## Plumbing Pre-Apprenticeship Evening Classes at Area 31 Career Center for Fall Semester 2025

**Instructional Hours:** 140 hours

**Program Overview:** The WTAE-Career Training Plumbing Program trains students to work as an entry level plumbing pre-apprentice. The program teaches students industry terminology, about plumbing equipment and tools and how to design, install, repair and maintain piping systems such as soil, waste, vent, potable water, wastewater treatment, gas systems (medical, propane, and natural) in residential, commercial, industrial buildings and at utility sites. Students will also learn about the various opportunities in the different plumbing fields. Mandatory NCCER CORE Bootcamp August 18-21. Mandatory Field Experiences will take place beginning Week 11. Employment placement opportunities are available to students after the completion of the program.

**Certifications:** NCCER Level 1 Plumbing Certification, WIN Essential Soft Skills Certification, and OSHA-10 General Construction.

- 6. **Complete** TABE testing 3 hours.
- 7. **Attend-** a 30-minute virtual interview.
- At the conclusion of interviewing and testing, the selection committee will review all candidate files.

Competitive selections will be made for awarding of scholarships.
